2012 FEE SCHEDULE

CANCELLATION POLICY – SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Written notice of withdrawal must be given for course cancellation. The Registration fee is non-refundable. **Before Start Date:** If cancellation notice is given more than 4 weeks before the scheduled commencement date of a registered ESL program or a student VISA application is rejected, 100% of course fees will be refunded. The official letter of VISA rejection must be presented in the latter instance. If a cancellation notice is given **4 weeks or less** before the anticipated program start date then a 70% refund will be given. Any bank fees will be taken away from refunded amount. Student refunds will be made to agencies (when applicable) within 30 days after written notice is received from student.

After Start Date: If a student cancels within 5 calendar days of the start date of the program, BEC will return 50% of all tuition fees paid. No refund will be paid if a student cancels (or is dismissed) when more than 5 days of the program have been completed.

All cancellations must be submitted in writing.

Course downgrades are not allowed after course start date. There are no refunds for classes missed due to holiday, graduation, orientation, and / or other situations beyond the school's control. In this policy, the word "course" refers to the full cycle of studies which the student registered for.

ACCOMMODATION CANCELLATION

Homestay – Before Arrival: If written cancellation notice is given 12 weeks or more before beginning of Homestay, all money will be refunded including Homestay Placement Fee. If written cancellation notice is given less than 12 weeks before the beginning of homestay, all money will be refunded except for the Homestay Placement Fee.

Homestay - After Arrival: The student should inform BEC in writing 3 weeks before the intended check-out date if he/she decides to terminate the agreed Homestay period. A \$100 change fee will be placed on Homestay changes when at least 3 weeks notice is given. If the notification period is less than 3 weeks, then in addition to the non-refundable notification period, a \$150 cancellation fee will apply.

After starting any accommodation placement, written notice of cancellation is to be submitted to the school 3 weeks before the intended departure date. A refund will be given only for fees paid beyond the 3 week period and is calculated from the date the notification is received. Accommodation deposits (not for Homestay) will only be returned when all rules and regulations are followed.

Application Process: A letter of acceptance (LOA) will be issued upon receipt of the completed registration form and payment in full. The original copy may be mailed, faxed, or emailed upon request. The school is not responsible for any extra courier charges.

For our main English Communication Program new students can start any Monday (unless Monday is a holiday in which case they will start on the Tuesday of the same week). However, absolute beginners must register for a minimum of 5 hours of private lessons before they can start group lessons. Students must arrive by 8:30am on their first day.

Airport shuttle cancellations must be made at least 3 weeks before scheduled shuttle. No refund of airport shuttle fees will be given in the event of last minute changes in flight plans. Students arriving more than 1 hour after scheduled arrival time may need to pay additional pick-up fees.

Credit selections must be made by the end of the 3rd week of each month (for the following month). Students joining programs with credits must select their activities and use all of their credits before this deadline. Students arriving without using their credits may find that they have fewer choices. These students must use all of their credits the morning of their first day or else, Banff Education Centre will select the student's schedule for them.

All students need to agree with all of the terms and conditions of joining BEC courses/programs. Students are asked to sign our Student Agreement/Waiver before arriving or making tuition payments. Students arriving without signing these required forms will not be given a refund if they decide they cannot sign the waiver and therefore are not able to join their course.

Any complaints brought by a student or its agent, against BEC, concerning BEC's services, accommodation and/or other matters, must be brought to BEC's attention by written notification and must be signed by the student.
